Liability, Insurance, and Indemnification. VENDOR accepts full responsibility for its operation on the Festival site, including the time of the transportation to and from the site, set-up, tear-down, and operation at the event; and will provide insurance coverage as provided below. On or before June 14, 2019, VENDOR will furnish Downtown Denver Events, Inc. ("DDE") a certificate of insurance as required below and carried by VENDOR with a financially responsible insurance company satisfactory to DDE. Said certificate will specifically name:

DOWNTOWN DENVER EVENTS, INC.; DENVER CIVIC VENTURES; INC.; DOWNTOWN DENVER PARTNERSHIP, INC.; DOWNTOWN DENVER, INC.; CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER; STATE OF COLORADO; and each of DDE's affiliates and respective board members, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, and subsidiaries as additional insured's for damages which may be sustained as a consequence of VENDOR's exercise of its obligations at the Festival, with the limits of liability not less than those indicated below. Said policy shall provide that such insurance shall not be canceled or changed in any material way except upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to all parties. Said insurance policy must be in effect from August 21, 2019 through September 10, 2019. The types of insurance required and the minimum limits are as follows:

- **General and Product Liability.** Bodily injury and property damage insurance in the amount of not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit.
- **Automobile Liability.** Bodily injury and property damage insurance in the amount of not less than \$500,000 combined single limit.
- **Worker's Compensation.** Statutory worker's compensation insurance as required by the State of Colorado and Employer's Liability insurance in the amounts of \$100,000 / \$500,000 / \$100,000.
- **VENDOR's Property.** Vendor must insure its equipment against loss, theft, or damage while the equipment is on the Premises. DDE assumes no liability for loss, theft, or damage to Vendor's equipment.

VENDOR agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless DOWNTOWN DENVER EVENTS, INC.; DENVER CIVIC VENTURES; INC.; DOWNTOWN DENVER PARTNERSHIP, INC.; DOWNTOWN DENVER, INC.; CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER; STATE OF COLORADO; and each of DDE's affiliates and respective board members, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, and subsidiaries against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, costs, and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) which are occasioned directly or indirectly by VENDOR's operations, including without limitation, injury or damages to persons or property which may result from the actions of VENDOR, its agents, and employees. The term "agents and employees of VENDOR" shall be deemed to include, but is not limited to, all operators, employees or representatives thereof and all parties with whom VENDOR contracts for the production, and / or operation of their booth at the Festival.
